Welcome to Porchester Hall

Porchester Hall's Grade II listed classic art deco design and understated elegance make it a sought-after venue for weddings of all sorts.

The grand entrance to the Hall is ideal for reception drinks and leads guests up the elegant staircase with its ornamental bronze and wrought banisters, striking marble walls and crystal chandelier. From the stairway, guests are led through to the Main Hall, which is the very essence of grandeur and opulence.

History

Porchester Hall was opened in 1929 alongside the Turkish Baths and Library on Porchester Road. It provided the Borough of Paddington with a dignified Public Hall intended primarily for use by the residents in the area but its beauty and convenience appealed to a wider circle. The foundation stone was laid by the Mayor Leonard Snell, JP, and this can be found at main entrance to the hall.


Main Hall

The grand entrance is ideal for reception drinks and leads guests up the elegant staircase with its ornamental bronze and wrought iron banisters, striking marble walls and crystal chandelier. From the stairway, guests are led through to the Main Hall, which is the very essence of grandeur and opulence. The Hall walls are handsomely panelled in English oak and walnut, with luxurious rich crimson velvet curtains. Fascinating figurines and motifs support the main beams, while ten magnificent crystal chandeliers, adorned in gold leaf effect, hang from the superbly engraved ceiling.

The lavish Main Hall can accommodate up to 600 guests for a standing reception; 450 in theatre style for a ceremony and 450 for a seated dinner.

Small Hall, Duchess of York Suite and Blue Room



The Small Hall is a delightful venue in its own right, ideal for smaller weddings of up to 50 guests.











Main Hall Floor Plans


Banquet 450 (400 with a dance floor)

Car parking


There are two NCP car parks within 100 yards of the hall on Queensway and Porchester Terrace North.
